

# 10 FACTS ABOUT YOUR PROGRAM



## 1 TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

We will pick you up on the day that the program starts (from 9am up to 9pm). If you would arrive on different dates or hours, you will need to get to your assigned housing by yourself (we will indicate you how to get there).

## 2 EMERGENCIES

For emergencies out of Educatrip office hours, you need to contact the emergency phone number (check the number on the schedule). By an emergency, we mean any extreme situation that must be solved at that very moment, not later.



## 3 INSURANCE

Please, bear in mind that you need to get insured during your time abroad. Educatrip staff will help you out with everything that is considered as an emergency during your time in Spain. Any further health treatment: medical study, medical exams, etc. will be your responsibility.



## 4 HOUSING

Living with a host family requires an adaptation period to get use to the new customs, habits, food, etc. If you are an independent person who loves living on your own, the residence hall can fit you well. In both cases, we would like you to be patient in adapting to the new way of living.



## 5 CLASSES

CILYC, CLCE or CEH classes can be scheduled at any time of the day, unlike CILE (only in the mornings).

- If you do not manage to pass the level test requirements for the CILYC (level 4 = intermediate or above), you will have to switch to CILE.
- CEH Course requires to be in level 7 = advanced or above.



## 6 WEATHER

Granada's climate can change significantly from one side to the other. This is due to the city's geographic location. The temperatures in summer are logically hot and there's not AC in every housing, but families have fans to make your stay as comfortable as needed.



## 7 MONEY

Bringing a big amount of cash along with you is not advisable since all change offices charge a fairly high commission. You can always withdraw some money in an ATM with a reasonable commission.



## 8 ACTIVITIES

You are fully responsible for planning and managing every personal plan (trips/activities) outside of the Educatrip program. We will not be held liable under any circumstances for any problems that may occur during that plan.



## 9 LEAVING GRANADA

It is not possible to lengthen the accommodation time with the housing assigned family when the program ends. Staying in the city or traveling out of Granada is your responsibility once the program comes to an end.
