Price includes:

• Reception in Granada. • Enrollment and tuition fees at the High School/University. • Full board accommodation in a single room with a family during the student stay in Granada • Health Insurance valid for the Spanish territory that will cover the whole stay of the student in this country. • The management, arrangements and help from ILYC staff about everything which is included in the program • Academic program (it includes the registration and a certification with marks for the stay in the high school), cultural and leisure program, accommodation and reception as well as the setting-up of the meeting and social center which will be used as information and activity center.

Price DOES NOT include:

• Round trip ticket to Spain. • Insurance for repatriation or any charges derived from the procedures for obtaining a visa. • Any alternative excursions or activities planned by the students - not included in the program - during their stay in Granada. • Any charges derived from the bank transfer. The corresponding commissions will be at the student expenses.

Option 1*	
31 st August – 16 th September	<p>Option for studying a Spanish Intensive Course in the University of Granada. This option will help you to improve your Spanish level very quickly and to be better prepared for the classes at the high school. Courses can be during the mornings or the afternoons.</p>
Option 2	
11 th September	<p>Welcome by ILYC Staff and introduction to the host family. You will be received by a member of ILYC and he/she will introduce you to the host family. You will be accommodated with a host family in a single room on a full board basis during the whole program.</p>
14 th September	<p>Beginning of the Course at the High School: You will be established in a level for your age in the Spanish Bachillerato/ESO System with the Spanish students. You will take all the lessons with the rest of students at the high school and you can participate in the activities organized in the high school: sports, complementary classes, trips...</p> <p>Meeting in ILYC A member of ILYC office will meet you for the first information and notices in Granada.</p> <p>Information meeting We'll give you some advices, directions and rules of the program, as well as some practical information about the city (maps, leisure, etc.)</p> <p>First stroll in town: We will take you for a walk through the city centre giving you also practical information. This is an orientation tour.</p> <p>First courses. A member of ILYC will go with you to the high school.</p>
From 14 th September to 22 nd December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Courses at the high school. - Courses usually take place during the morning: From 8:30 to 14:30 with one or two breaks during these times from Monday to Friday. - Lunch is around 15:00 and extra activities from 16:30 to 20:00.
