CILE (Intensive Spanish Language Course)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Four levels: Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced and Superior. Each level has two subdivisions (A and B). ➤ Four teaching hours per day. ➤ Students are placed in one of the eight levels according to their test results. The minimum number of students per group is 5 and the average number is usually 12. 	
Optional courses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ One of the subjects on the right column can be chosen by students to study at the same time than they study the CILE course. ➤ They are optional and involve 20 more hours each. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Spanish Business</i> ➤ <i>Spanish Civilisation and Culture.</i>
