SCHEDULE OF THE SUMMER PROGRAMS

Day 1 (see table on page 1)	Arrival in Granada, welcome by Ilyc Staff and introduction to host families. The students will be accommodated with a family on a full board basis during the whole program.	
Day 2	Meeting to go to the Modern Languages Center (CLM) A member of the host family will take the student to ILYC office where she'll meet ILYC staff to be escorted to the CLM to take the placement test. Spanish language level test consisting of a written test and a short oral interview. Information meeting We'll give the students some advices, directions and rules of the program, as well as some practical information about the city (maps, leisure, etc.) First stroll in town: We will take the students for a walk through the city center giving them also practical information.	
Academic Program	OPTION 1: CILE 80 hours	Intensive Spanish Language Course (CILE, 80 hours) ▶ 8 levels ▶ This course combines Spanish language and grammar according to the syllabus for each level.

Latin American Literature (20 hours) 3. Spanish Literature (20 hours) 4. Spanish Geography (20 hours) 5. Spanish History (20 hours) 6. History of Art in Spain (20 hours) 7. Spanish Civilization and Culture (20 hours) 8. Islamic Culture in Spain (20 hours) 9. Latin American Civilization and Culture (20 hours) 10. Varieties of Spanish (20 hours) 11.
